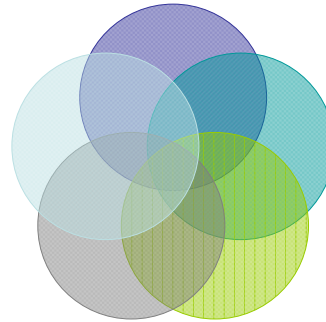

Quality Assurance Programming, Adverse Events, and Outcome Based Quality Improvement

Opportunities to improve client care will focus on mandatory Federal and State Regulations such as: Clinical Record Reviews on a quarterly basis (Federal Regulation); Quality Assessment Performing Improvement (State Regulation); Adverse Event Outcome Reports (Federal Regulation); and Outcome Based Quality Improvement (Federal Regulation).
