Subject: **Provider Letter 09-13** – Emergency Preparedness Reminder

Hurricane season is June 1 through November 30. This letter is a reminder for a provider to review its emergency preparedness and response plan and of the resources available in the event of an emergency.

A provider must ensure that its emergency preparedness plan is up-to-date and meets the needs of individuals it serves, that appropriate personnel are aware of their responsibilities, and that it coordinates with its local emergency management coordinator in the event of an emergency. The Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) recommends that licensees review their licensure rules on the minimum eight core elements of emergency preparedness and Provider Letter 08-22 (http://www.dads.state.tx.us/providers/communications/2008/letters/PL2008-22.pdf) regarding the Facility Inventory, Vacancy and Evacuation Status (FIVES) system.
